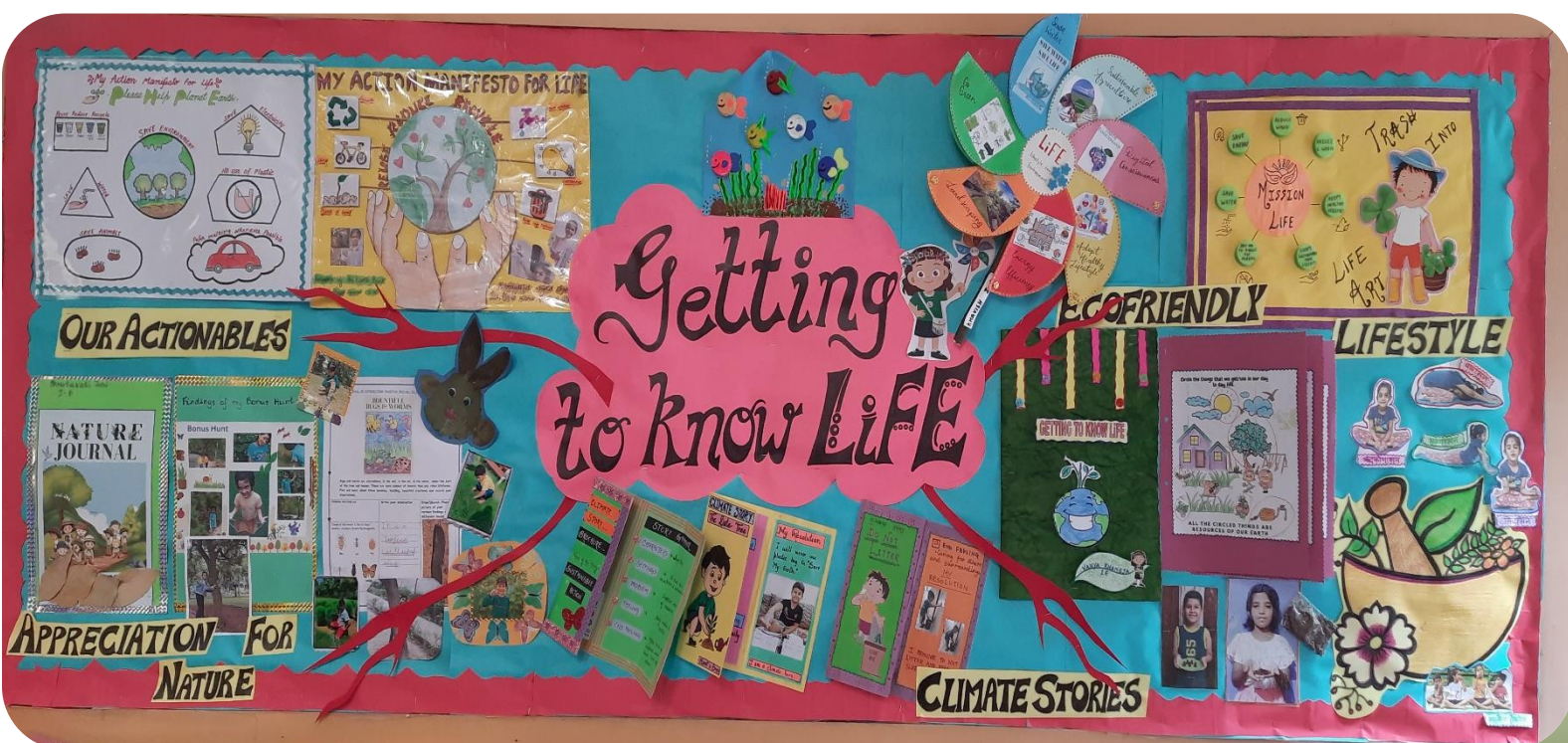


#INVEST IN YOUR PLANET
