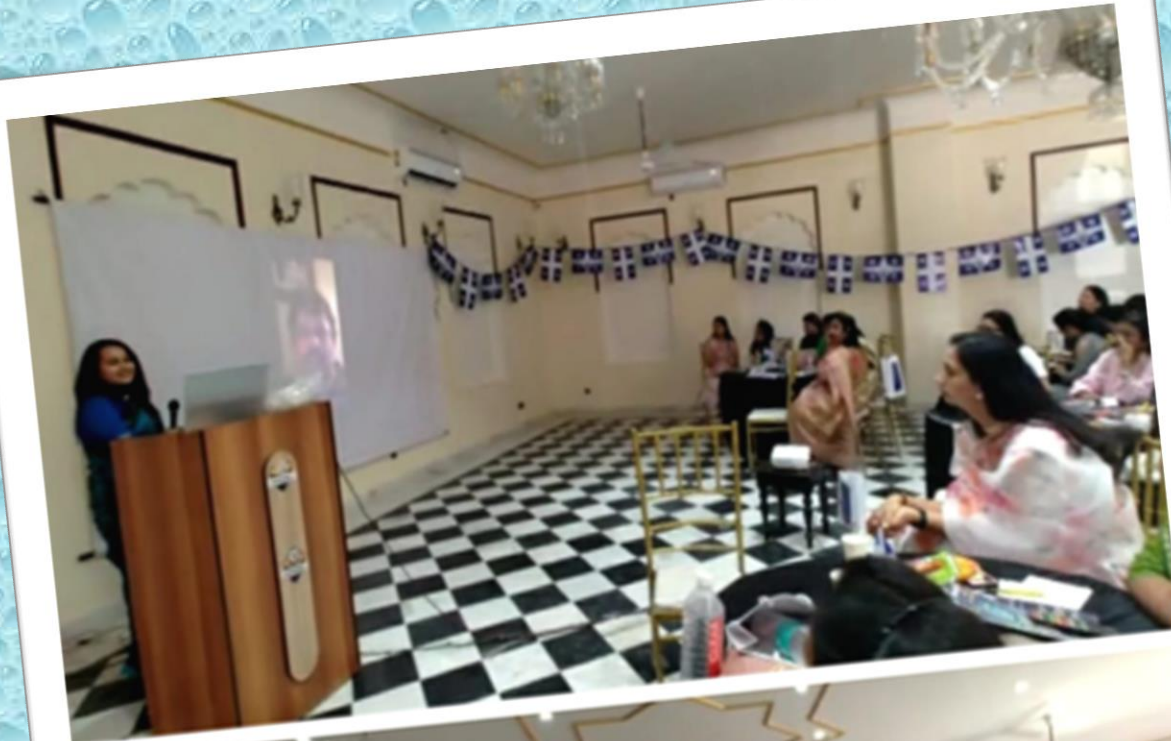


NEW BEGINNINGS WITH FREE PLAY

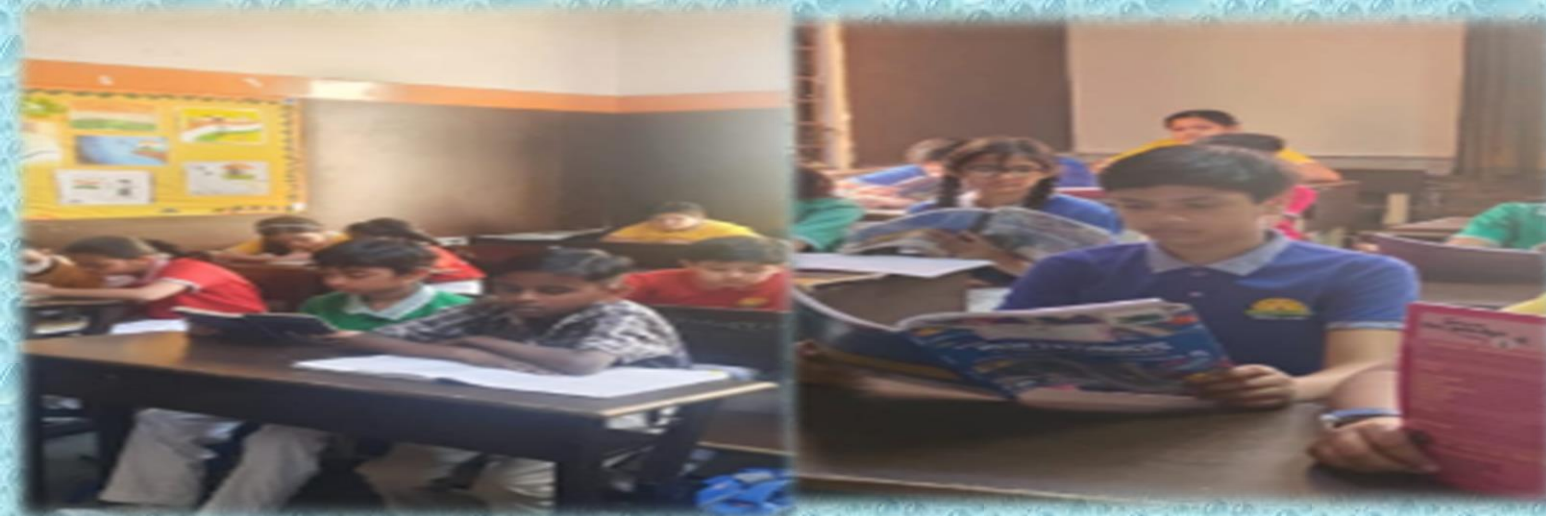


STAGE DE FORMATION



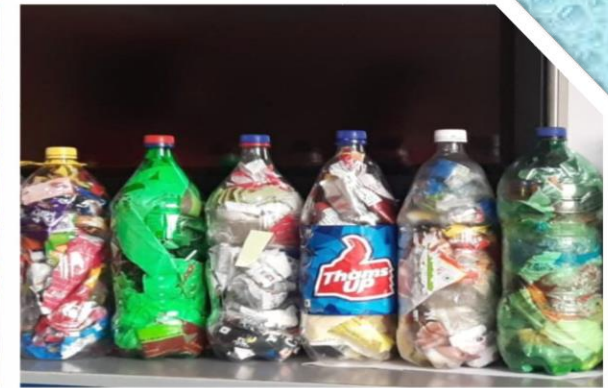

DEAR, DEARS



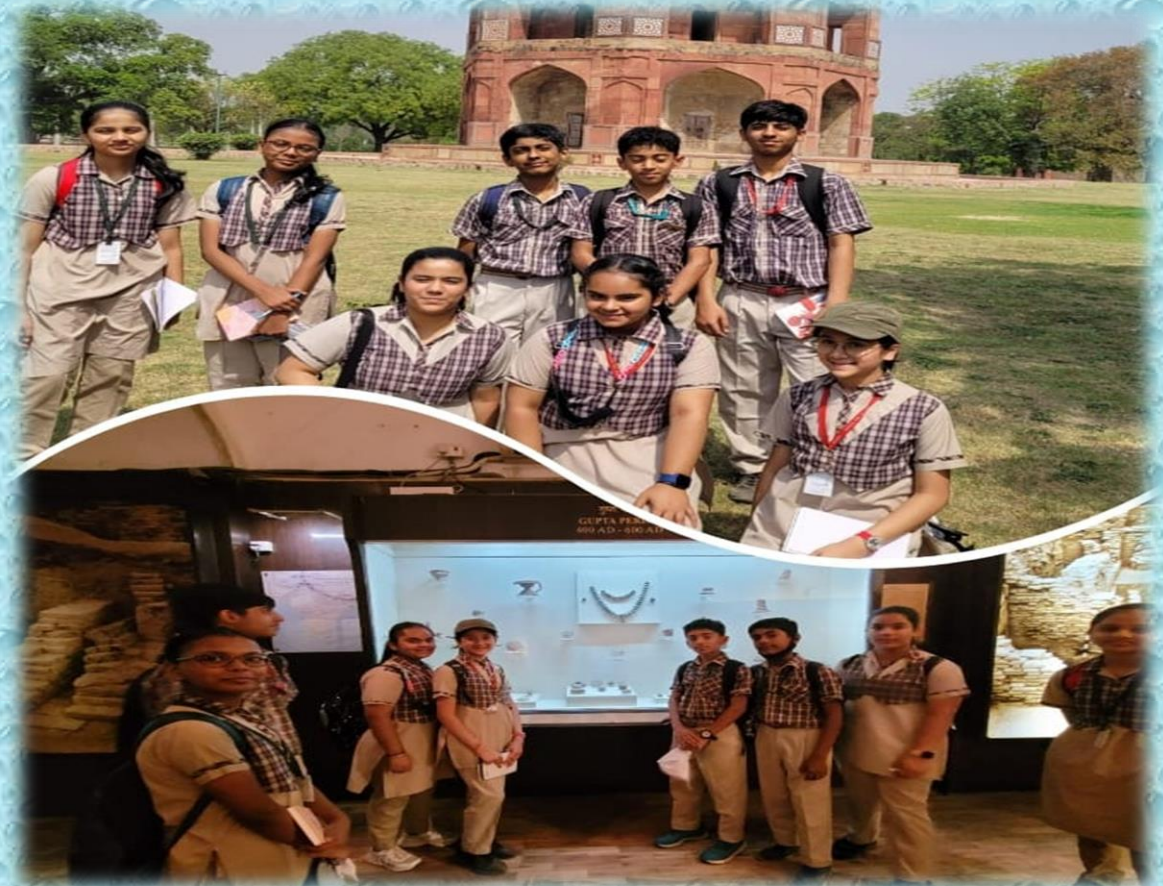

The school, in accordance with INTACH, took the students of middle wing for a visit to Purana Qila excavation site. Excavation took place under ASI (Archaeological Survey of India).

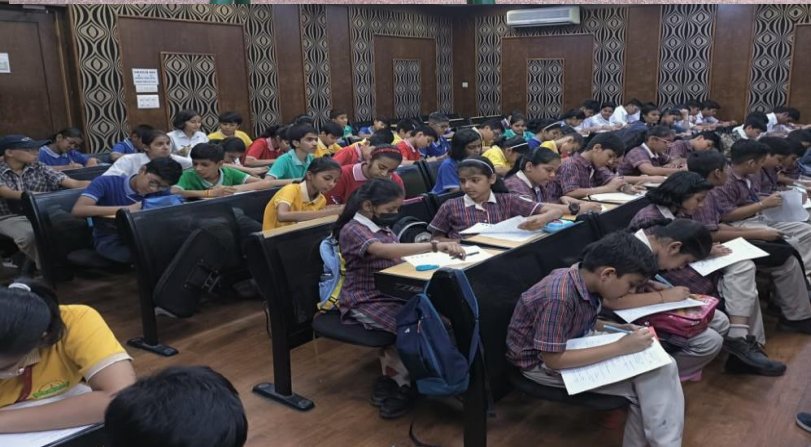
Conquering highest scale in Koti Chail

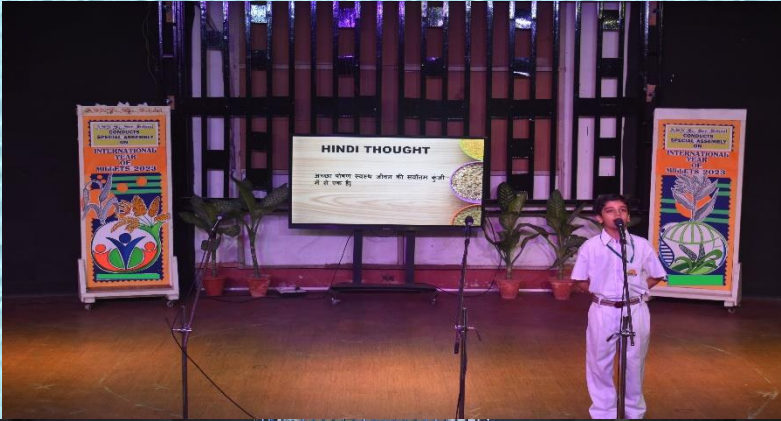
In the summer break, a Road safety summer camp was organised by the school to apprise our little ones of the road safety rules and civic sense through various activities.
