# WORLD SCOUTS & THINKING DAY

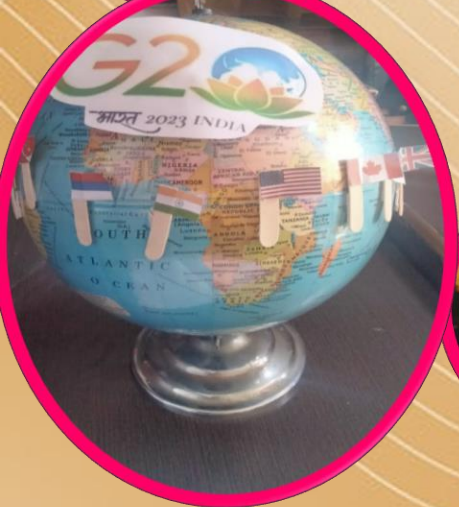
World Scouts' Day or Guides' Day is also observed as World Thinking Day worldwide, on 22 February each year.
