Regularly incorporated games, songs, creative projects, storytelling sessions, roleplays, free hand drawings, and painting help develop children's foundational skills
in literacy and numeracy. Singing, rhyming and reciting are some strategies
employed in the Language Arts and the Phonics Programme. Activity areas or
learning centres are set up in the classroom, with resources that actively engage
children to learn about particular themes or topics. Besides the academic platform,
we include non-academic subjects as a vital part of our curriculum. The children are
encouraged to play, explore, discover and communicate through Physical
Education, Dance, Music, Art and Craft.

We ensure to create an effective balance between a clearly defined structure that impacts all children, and a flexibility that allows for individualization for children, within the classroom.

I look forward to working closely with you in maintaining the continuity of the best learning and teaching environment for our children.




SUPERHEROES OF the EARTH


'Life doesn't come with a manual but with a Mother.'

Play Activities to Encourage Motor Development

Gross and fine motor skills are an essential tool that children use in the classroom and on the playground. Play is one of the best ways to strengthen motor skills. We give ample opportunities to play with a variety of interesting materials which help our young children grow in many new and exciting ways.



PRACTICAL LIFE ACTIVITIES (PLE)

In doing Practical Life Activities (PLE), the child can develop a high level of concentration, develop a sense of order, take pride in completing a job, increase independence. Various activities were done keeping in mind all these aspects like-rolling/unrolling of table mat, pegging activity, pink tower, stacking and sorting etc.







SKILLS

Developing Fine motor Skills

Fine motor skills involve the use of the small muscles that control the hand, fingers, and thumb. They help children perform important tasks like feeding themselves, grasping toys, writing and drawing. Many carefully planned activities were done to develop the motor skills of students like- tearing and pasting activity, paper crumpling and colouring.






CREATIVE EXPRESSION

Students enjoyed learning about primary and secondary colours with the help of different activities and games. Little ones enjoyed 'Colour Scavenger Hunt' game related to colours. They also did dabbing and vegetable printing in different objects related to various colours. They had fun sorting different colour objects from the basket.

Our budding artists have started creating things using clay. They are even able to draw simple things.



Within and without the walls of the classrooms, the children are exposed to an environment where learning takes place through observations, predictions, comparisons, and conducting investigations. They are encouraged to find answers for themselves; and yet being able to approach their teachers who are facilitators in the journey, discovery, and sense and wonder.





The topic was introduced with help of open-ended questions and students enthusiastically started sharing about their favourite things related to the season. Virtual aids, flash cards and real objects were also shared. They showed their creativity in scrapbook by making tempting ice creams.

Well Being



Early years are critical years in which children learn to make sense of themselves in relation to the world around them. We provide a caring environment where our children can feel confident to take risks, whilst feeling safe, supported and loved. We guide children in the process of learning through playing, sharing, negotiating, and expressing their feelings appropriately. Through storytelling and our SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING (SEL) Program, the children are encouraged to handle their emotions, be it kindness, resilience, courage, appreciation through affirmation by their peers and adults around them.

Different activities were done to help students learn the art of managing their emotions, achieve set goals and show empathy towards others. Students gave self-introduction with the help of "Me and My Buddy" activity.

Exploring Sounds




Before introducing the students with the letter sound, they were made aware with the sounds in the environment. Montessori Sensory apparatus was used to help them explore the surrounding sounds.
