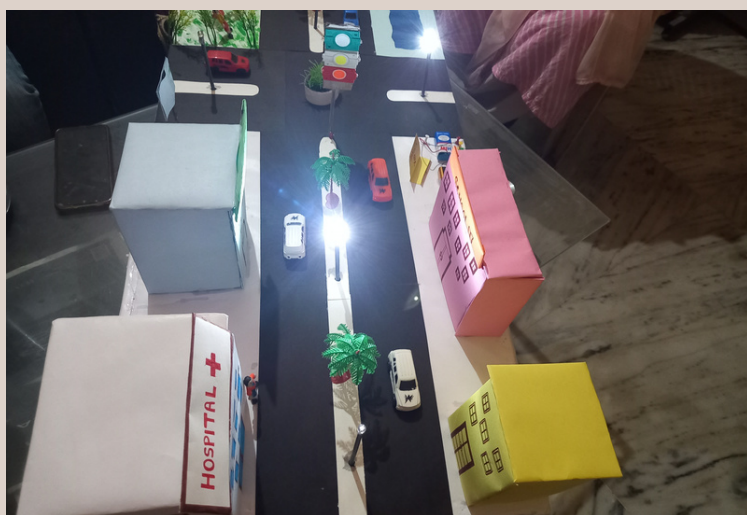




CLASS EXHIBITION

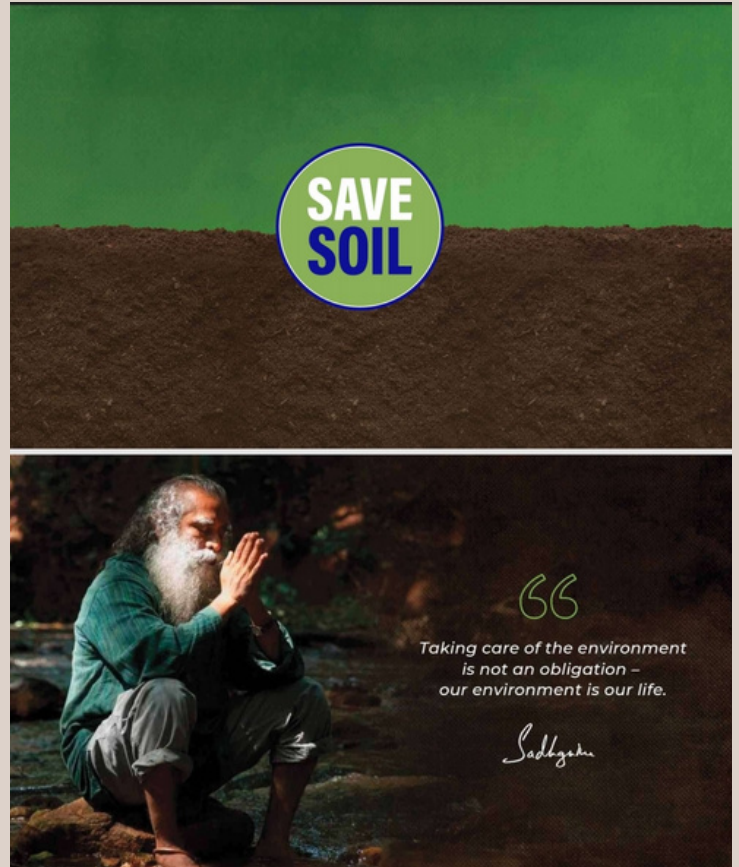


SOIL CONSERVATION

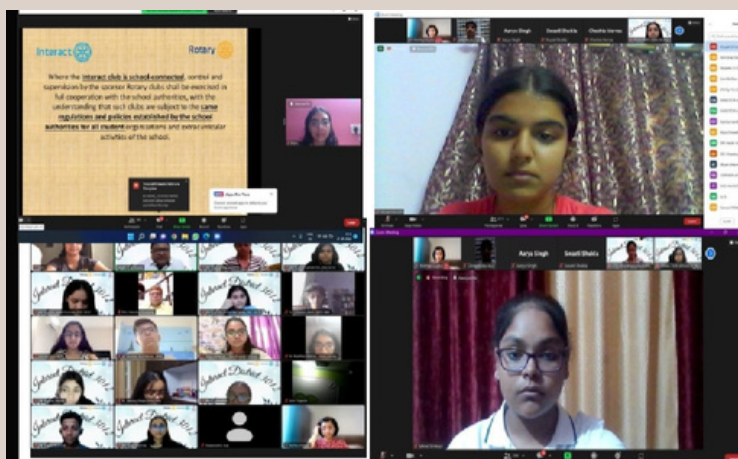
PLANTATION DRIVE

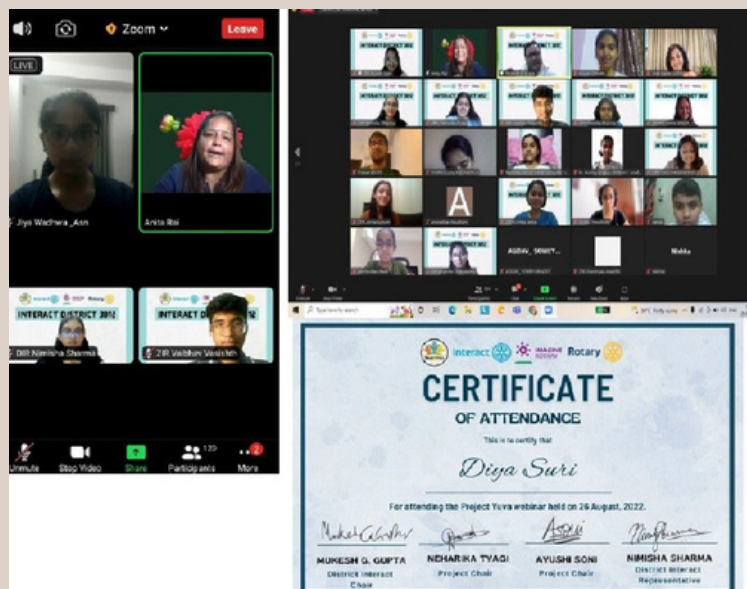
INTERACT CLUB

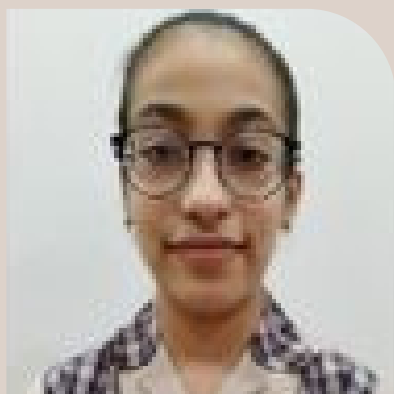

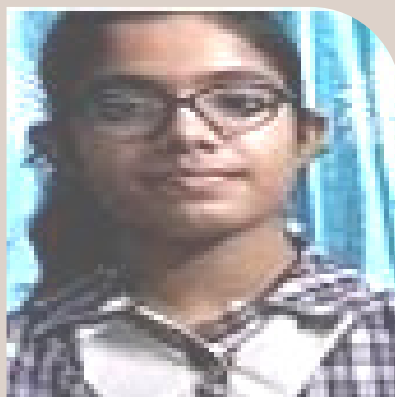

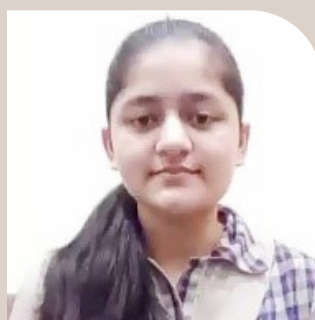
