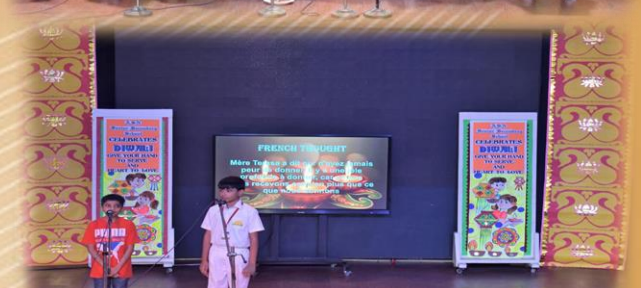

ASSEMBLIES



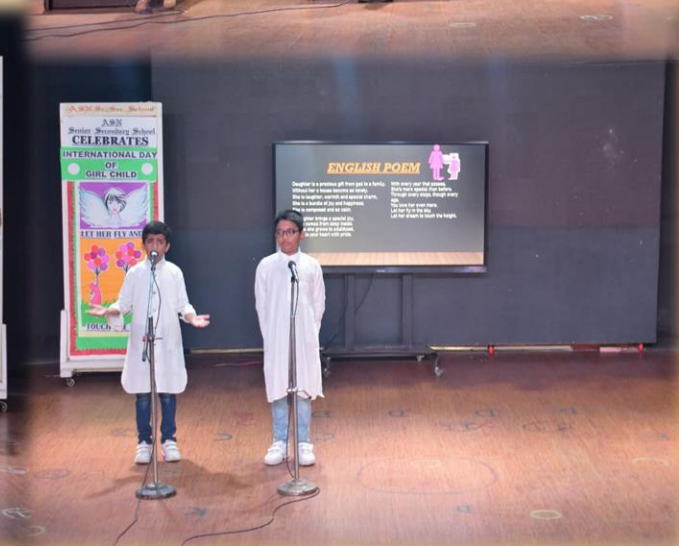
