C3 - COMIC CANVAS CONTEST


(COMIC STRIP DESIGNING)

- 2. One team of 2 students per school is permissible.
- 3. The comic strip should be presented on an A3 sheet using variety of colours.
- 4. The comic strip must have a panel of 8 frames.
- 5. The cartoon/comic presentation should not be derogatory in any sense towards any particular individual of the society.
- 6. Work should be original. Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- 7. A3 sheets will be provided; Colours/ Art materials and drawing board to be carried by the participants.
