



13 CLIMATE ACTION

The intend behind this activity was to motivate young learners to adopt healthy dietary choices and bringing them closer to environment, enabling them to practice healthy living with healthy food.






## Green Doodle










# GARDEN MATH










# LIFESKILLS WATCH


